We are proud to share our unique course with you – a specialist BA programme in painting – offered at only a handful of institutions in the UK. In Art and Design, students have the option of undertaking a Foundation Diploma or going straight onto a BA programme, as I am sure you are aware.

As an outline, students have the opportunity to develop a personal practice in painting through a range of technical, philosophical and aesthetic approaches to the subject over the three years of the course. Students benefit from large studio spaces and generous tutorial time with lecturers (each experienced and practicing painters), alongside a range of other teaching methods. The course especially suits students who want to develop a specialist practice in painting and want to live at home and commute, or move only a short distance for Higher Education.

Introduction to the Allied Health Professions – Occupational Therapy and Mature Students Special

An Occupational Therapist helps people continue their work, studies, leisure activities and everyday tasks during illnesses, injuries, disabilities or ageing. They can help people learn to use assistive technology, help adapt their home or workplace to meet their needs, and work with people to find new ways to approach tasks. This session will provide an overview of the AHPs, an in-depth look into the role of a Occupational Therapist and information on what it is like to study an AHP course as a mature student. You will hear information from a member of the I See The Difference team and from an active Occupational Therapist who studied Occupational Therapy as a mature student at university.

Introduction to the Allied Health Professions – Paramedic Special

A paramedic responds to a range of emergency and non-emergency situations, travelling in an ambulance or car, or by bike or motorbike. Whatever the situation, paramedics are usually the first health professionals on the scene. They assess patients and make potentially life-saving decisions about whether and how to treat people at the scene, or transfer them to hospital.
