
The Army Officer Scholarship Scheme (AOSS) can support students through school and university, so they'll have a career as an Army Officer secured by the time they finish their education.

The applications for October Pathways Work Experience programme for Years 11 & 12 are now open. Following up on the success of the July programme we will again offer the programme in two formats. For students who live close enough to travel to our offices in West London there is an option of a hybrid week with the Monday and Friday in the office at Bedfont Lakes, Feltham and also a fully virtual option. #### **Futures Programmes**

Our three programmes, Dental Futures, Medicine Futures, and Psychology Futures, are designed to inspire and support Year 12 students interested in pursuing careers in Dentistry, Medicine, or Psychology. Each programme will help students develop their skills and subject knowledge, giving them the opportunity to take part in talks, workshops, and other enrichment activities alongside their current studies.

**Dental Futures and Medicine Futures** run for twelve months from January 2023. Applications open on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2022 and close Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> November 2022. 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## Lucy Cavendish Academic Enrichment Programme 2022/2023 Cambridge University

This free programme will support high-achieving Year 12 state school students throughout the academic year, providing comprehensive supplementary academic support tailored to their stage in the curriculum, and giving them the best chance of achieving their full potential. Students will attend weekly online subject-specific enrichment classes from November 2022 to March 2022, which will strengthen students' skills and knowledge with the aim of raising attainment and confidence in their current studies. A range of additional subject taster sessions, alongside the completion of a Super curricular Enrichment Project in May, will allow students to explore their subject interests further and think more seriously about possible degree choices. ## STEM SMART Programme (Year 12) January 2023 – May 2024

STEM SMART is a free, 17-month programme to support students in raising their attainment at school and develop their confidence to apply to study STEM subjects at top universities. This programme is specifically designed for students who are considering applying to Engineering, Physical Sciences (eg physics, chemistry, earth sciences, materials science) or Biological Sciences (eg plant sciences, pharmacology, physiology, evolution and behaviour, biochemistry) courses at university and are studying A Levels (or equivalent) in maths and sciences. The scheme is free to all participants. ## Cambridge Students' Union Shadowing Scheme (Year 12)

### January-February 2023

Cambridge SU is re-launching its in-person Shadowing Scheme for 2023. During the scheme, participants come to Cambridge, 'shadow' an undergraduate mentor who is studying a subject they're interested in, attend lectures, stay in a student room, eat in a college dining hall, meet lots of current students at a range of events and activities, and get advice on applying to Cambridge from staff and students. Participants will also get the chance to stay in contact with their mentor after the scheme, and attend online application and study skills sessions, in order to help them make well-informed, successful University applications. The scheme is free to all participants, including accommodation and meals, and travel costs will be reimbursed.
