The venue for all examinations is the HALL unless otherwise indicated. Lists of individual seat numbers for each exam will be displayed on the exam notice board in the covered way prior to each exam. Candidates should be seated in their allocated place by the following times:

8.45 a.m. for morning exams
1.15 p.m. for afternoon exams

Between **Monday 18th November** and **Friday 29th November**, students need only attend school when they have an examination. When students do not have an exam, they are expected to remain at home and make good use of this time for revision purposes. Normal timetable will resume on **Monday 2nd December**.

ALL boys should be equipped with black pen (+ spare), pencil (+ spare), ruler, rubber, angle-measurer, compasses, and a calculator. These should be contained in a **CLEAR** pencil case or plastic bag.
