Dear Parent/Carer,

We are running another A level Religious Studies Trip and this year we are linking with the Art and Photography department. Within the Religious Studies syllabus your/son daughter need to make connections with how religious and philosophical concepts are portrayed through art, therefore we have decided to run a trip which links the two departments.

Details of the trip;

Dates: Sunday 4th February 2018

Liverpool to Paris Charles de Gaulle/Flight details - Departure 18:30 Arrival 21:00

Dates: Wednesday 8th February 2018

Paris Charles de Gaulle to Liverpool/Flight details - Departure 20:35 Arrival 21:05

Trip activities and accommodation include;

- 3 nights half board accommodation – included breakfast and lunch or evening meal.
- Eiffel Tower.
- Unguided visit to the Louvre.
- Unguided visit to the Musée d’Orsay.
- Paris Catacombs
- Notre Dame and the Sacre-Coeur.
- 1 day, 2 park pass for the Disneyland Resort.

This trip will cost £520 and a £225 deposit is required by 22nd September. Your son/daughter will need an up to date passport (they will keep this) and EHIC card (I will collect). If you wish your son to take part in this trip and to secure his place, please complete the attached reply-slip enclosing a deposit of £225.00 and return to Ms Kinloch. This payment can also be made via Parentmail (+Pay) we have in school, or by cash/cheque (*made payable to ‘St Margaret’s School fund’*). Please circle how you will make the payment on the return slip below.

The trip activities will be beneficial to the students in term of both exam papers, for example visiting the Louvre and Musee D’Orsay will help their understanding of Religion and Art (Paper One). Also visiting the catacombs will help with history of Christianity and visiting the churches will help with their understanding with the symbolism of sacraments (Paper Two). On returning your son/daughter (as part of the 6th Form JMU citizenship award) will teach what they have learnt to a KS3 class and/or give an assembly to lower school. This will help reinforce what they have learnt from this experience and also share they knowledge with younger students as well as acting as good role models.

There are limited spaces on this trip (24 places) so early return of the slip below is advisable.
