Dear Parents/Carers,

The Food & Nutrition Department is organising a visit to this year's BBC Good Food Show for the Year 10 Hospitality & Catering class. The show is a fantastic opportunity for students to sample foods, watch top chefs demonstrating great recipes and learn more about new and favourite foods, ingredients and equipment. This is also an opportunity for the students to undertake primary research relevant to their exam controlled assessment that they will be starting in September.

The show is taking place at the Birmingham NEC on Friday 15th June 2018. We will need to depart from school at 8.30am and will return back to school at approximately 7.00pm. Please make the necessary transport arrangements to and from school for your son.

Students can bring a packed lunch if they wish or they can bring money to purchase lunch at the show. Food prices on the day will range so bringing some sandwiches may be useful.

Students should bring with them any personal medication that may be required on the day, i.e. inhalers, epipen, antihistamines etc.

To cover the cost of transport and entrance, the school asks for a voluntary contribution of £20.00. If the voluntary contributions do not cover the cost of this trip, we regret it may have to be cancelled. In line with a recent change to our Charging Policy, pupils for whom we receive Pupil Premium funding (eg. those entitled, or previously entitled, to Free School Meals) will not be required to make a voluntary contribution for this trip. This payment can be made via Parentmail (+Pay) we have in school, or by cash/cheque (*cheques should be made payable to St.Margarets's Academy School Fund*).
