Year 11 Option Subjects and Religious Studies Progress Examinations - March 2019

Following the success of our recent Revise to Five programme and a second round of progress examinations in English, Maths and Science, we would like all students to take part in a second progress examination in their option subjects and Religious Studies. These examinations will take place following the normal school day at 3.30-5.00pm (2.35-4.35pm on Thursdays) following the timetable shown on the reverse of this letter. Extra time supervision will be provided for those students who are entitled to it. We hope to ensure the least amount of disruption to normal lessons but provide students and parents with as accurate and up to date assessment as possible in all your son's subjects for the second Year 11 Parent Consultation on Thursday, 21st March.

The venue for all examinations is Rooms 51-53 unless otherwise indicated. Lists of individual seat numbers for each exam will be displayed on the exam notice board in the covered way prior to each exam. Candidates should be seated in their allocated place by 3.30pm (2.35pm on Thursdays).

ALL boys should be equipped with black pen (+ spare), pencil (+ spare), ruler, rubber, angle-measurer, compasses, and a calculator. These should be contained in a clear pencil case or plastic bag.

Mobile phones, ipods, MP3/4 players, smartwatches or potential technological/web enabled sources of information are not permitted in the examinations. Any of the above discovered will lead to cancellation of the marks for that paper. Examination boards invariably take drastic action against students who break these rules. Please impress this upon your son. Students are advised to leave mobile phones at home as we cannot be responsible for their safekeeping.
